2. AGREED SYLLABUS 2022

RECEIVED an update on progress of the new Enfield Agreed Syllabus 2022.

REPORTED the agreement in principle by SACRE members at the SACRE meeting held on 14 June 2022, the Agreed Syllabus Conference (ASC) recommendation to go ahead and adopt the RE Today Syllabus A+ with supplementary additional units to ensure that it reflects the diversity of the borough and for faith representatives to have the opportunity to be included in the planning of these units.

NOTED that

- There were no SACRE members represented from Group B.

RESOLVED that Lucy Nutt would liaise separately with Group B SACRE members on the proposals and outcomes from the meeting

- The additional units **recommended** to SACRE members for agreement are:

KS1 Buddhism	KS2 Buddhism	KS3 Buddhism

- The additional units are a minimum expectation and schools will be able to add more units, further units can also be added that reflect the particular borough context.
- A launch date of 19 January 2023 to schools was proposed. This will be a whole day of training offered to RE co-ordinators followed by the launch. SACRE members will be invited to attend if they wish to.
- The launch date will be a soft launch with schools starting to plan and use the new syllabus which should be fully implemented by September 2023.
- Julia Diamond Conway had had an online meeting with Rabbi Levy with regard to the KS3 Syllabus on Judaism and he had kindly agreed to review the revised unit plans. Rabbi Keren would also be invited to review the KS3 syllabus. Julia would e-mail both of them with the proposed KS3 syllabus for comments.
