11. HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY 2025

27 January 2025 marks the anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi death camp. Every year on that day Holocaust Memorial Day takes place.

The theme for Holocaust Memorial Day (HMD) 2025 is: For a Better Future.

The theme encapsulates our collective responsibility to shape a brighter tomorrow – such as confronting Holocaust and genocide denial, challenging prejudice, and promoting education about the Holocaust and more recent genocides.

In addition to the theme HMD Trust have launched a nationwide arts and education project – 80 candles for 80 years. 2025 marks 80 years since the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau. A digital exhibition of 80 bespoke candleholders are to be designed and created by communities across the UK that showcase the life of an individual or a community persecuted by the Nazis.

12. NATIONAL INTER FAITH WEEK 10-17 NOVEMBER 2024

Inter Faith Week has grown steadily ever since it was started by the Inter Faith Network (IFN) for the UK in 2009, in partnership with Government for the launch year. This will be the 16th Inter Faith Week.

Sadly the Inter Faith Network will be closing shortly, however a number of IFN's member bodies will be working together to take the Week forward in 2024.
